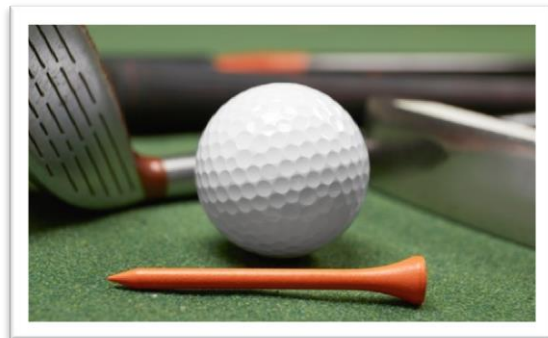
Three Private Golf Lessons at the Washington Golf Club – Value \$150

About the course: The 9-hole golf course is located at the end of Golf Course Road, just off Wykeham Road. The early development of the Golf Section was largely influenced by the thoughts and generosity of Mrs. Richard S. Barnes and of Mr. Alfred S. Bourne. In 1962, Paul Bruning purchased and gave to the Club twenty-seven acres of land adjacent to the present 4th fairway. In 1963, ten additional acres were purchased by thirty-four Club members and given to expand the golf course. Washington is one of the oldest golf clubs in the United States.

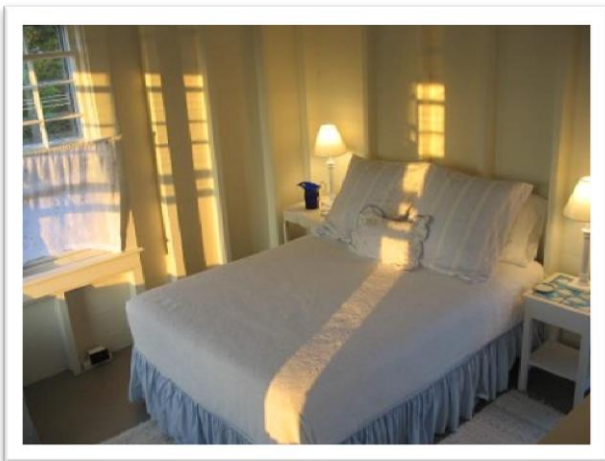

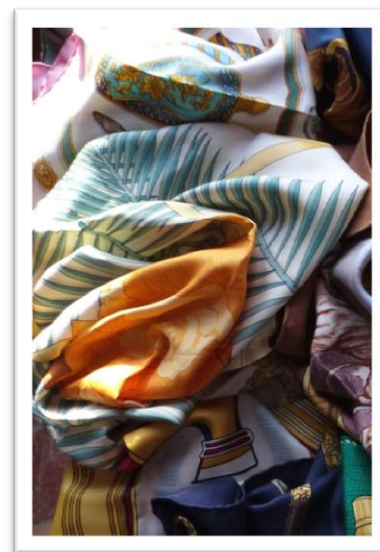
HERMÈS Scarf Value \$400 - \$600

The company of Waterford was first established in 1783 on land adjacent to Merchants' Quay in the heart of the Irish harbor town of Waterford, just minutes from the present day House of Waterford Crystal. Its founders were brothers, William and George Penrose, important developers and principal exporters in the city. Their vision was to "create the finest quality crystal for drinking vessels and objects of beauty for the home." More than two hundred years later, the reputation they established for creating glass of unsurpassed beauty and quality has transcended the intervening centuries.

Fun Fact - Waterford Crystal made the 2,688 **crystals** for the famous New Year's Eve Ball that is dropped each year in New York City's Times Square.

Come each Friday afternoon in June, July and August and whatever is ready to harvest in the garden will be ready for pick up. Quantity of veggies will be for two – four people and is dependent on the weather.

After Tillie Page Laird moved here full time in 2010, she wanted a garden. Using part of a field next to her house, she designed a 1,200 square foot garden surrounded by a deer fence and stone walls. Half of this was for vegetables and strawberries, and the other half was two-tiered for flowers. LG Landscaping built this using the best top soil mixed with sand, peat moss, and manure from cows, sheep, and horses. Starting in 2011, she entered many vegetables plus garlic and shallots at the Labor Day Goshen Fair, winning dozens of awards for her entries. Her strawberries couldn't be entered as they were ripe before the fair occurred. The garden is organic and thanks to excellent soil from day one, a minimum of organic fertilizer is used.
