The CT Department of Health, and the Bishops and Canons of ECCT, recommend canceling indoor events when in a Red Zone. The Governor limits gatherings to 10 people. So St. John's has once again closed the church building to the public, and will live-stream the Service on Sunday, with a minimum production crew.
